Riverflies are **insects**. Before they become adult flies, they live underwater in **freshwater** habitats. Three key groups of riverflies are **mayflies**, **stoneflies** and **caddisflies**. Riverfly **monitors** are people who do **surveys** on their local rivers where they count the number of riverflies. This helps to show how healthy the river is, as riverflies are **sensitive** to changes to their **habitats**, such as water **pollution**.
