<b>Attend ARMI training workshop</b>	One-day workshop delivered by RP certificated tutor (usually attended by area statutory body ecology contact) to train volunteers in all aspects of ARMI.	ARMI coordinator(s), tutor, statutory body ecology contact	Ensure standardised level of training delivered to all ARMI volunteers; continuity of ARMI
<b>Identify and register monitoring site</b>	Identify site to monitor once training is completed, gain landowner/fishery permission for access and to monitor, record site information as per ARMI site registration form, submit site registration form to ARMI local coordinator. This may happen during ARMI workshop.	Local ARMI coordinator, Landowner(s), Fisheries manager(s), statutory body ecology contact	Strategic development of ARMI site network, ensuring necessary permissions gained; statutory body approval of site locations and trigger levels set
<b>Carry out regular sampling at registered ARMI site(s)</b>	Sample in accordance with ARMI protocol, local ARMI group/hub framework and weather/river conditions	Fellow ARMI group monitor(s) ARMI group and hub coordinator	Regular trigger level check (acute pollution detection), 'eyes and ears' on riverbank (additional observations), contribution to ongoing catchment fisheries improvement, data reported to ARMI online, deter would be polluters.
<b>Follow ARMI trigger level breach protocol if 1<sup>st</sup> sample below site trigger level</b>	Conduct a 2 <sup>nd</sup> sample at the same site to confirm trigger breach (liaise with local ARMI coordinator). If trigger level is breached 2 <sup>nd</sup> time, immediately report to statutory body, ARMI coordinator and RP as per set	Local ARMI coordinator, Environment Agency, Riverfly Partnership	Detection and reporting of acute pollution incidents; appropriate statutory body response action; complements statutory body monitoring.
<b>General river pollution monitoring</b>	Obvious pollution indicators, e.g., dead fish, visible pollution, is immediately reported to Statutory Emergency incident line <b>0800 807060</b> , local statutory body contact, local ARMI coordinator, RP.	statutory body, local ARMI coordinator, RP	Effective, regular pollution monitoring and reporting network informing appropriate response action.
<b>General river/fisheries health monitoring</b>	Observe, record and report evidence of wider issues, e.g., INNS, illegal fishing.	statutory body, local ARMI coordinator, RP, appropriate recording/reporting mechanisms, e.g., Plant Tracker app	Improved datasets to inform fisheries/river management.
<b>Data Recording - Local</b>	Submits data into local recording sheet via ARMI coordinator	Local ARMI coordinator	Local data sharing with statutory agency data analysis and reporting
<b>Data Recording - National</b>	Submit data into ARMI database <a href="http://www.riverflies.org/">http://www.riverflies.org/</a>	RP	Online national ARMI dataset (verified records) available under OGL
