Set appropriate trigger level for each site according to agreed ARMI protocol. Confirm trigger levels with local ARMI coordinator.	Local ARMI coordinator(s), ARMI volunteers, RP	Ensure quality of site locations, ensure ARMI effective in detecting acute pollution incidents.
Respond to confirmed trigger level breach reports	Review ARMI data, determine if/what further action required, response/enforcement action if/as appropriate, provide feedback to ARMI group after every statutory action (or inaction) taken.	Local ARMI coordinator(s), ARMI volunteers, statutory colleagues, RP, polluter(s)	Effective, rapid pollution incident response; volunteer retention/motivation increased through quality feedback and actions.
Feedback of ARMI results	Review local ARMI data and provide comment to ARMI coordinator for inclusion in annual reports/regular newsletters	ARMI coordinators, statutory colleagues, ARMI volunteers	Increased angler/volunteer engagement with river ecology/health/fisheries improvement; improved volunteer commitment and motivation.
